That’s the message that will feature on each side of the fuselage of Canberra WT346 as it heads north by road and inter-island ferry from the Air Force Museum, Wigram to NZ Warbirds at Ardmore. In conjunction with the Air Force Museum we’re working on a plan to stimulate media coverage on the passage north to create wider awareness of the restoration.

Planned departure date is **Thursday 18 February** with arrival at Ardmore on **Saturday 20 February**. Precise ETA is unknown at this stage.

A huge step to mark the start of the restoration process; as soon as the fuselage is safely positioned we’ll contact you with a view to arranging a close-up view!
